Matt 28:1 Now after the Sabbath, as it began to dawn toward the first {day} of the week, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary came to look at the grave. 2 And behold, a severe earthquake had occurred, for an angel of the Lord descended from heaven and came and rolled away the stone and sat upon it.

Now, I don't know if your journey to Jesus "came softly," like the sunrise slowly lighting up the sky...or if it came like a light-switch, bringing light to your life instantly. But I do know that the power of Jesus' resurrection can bring new life to your dead soul as quickly as Jesus was raised from the dead.
