Message from Pastor Johnson

The Blood Will Never Lose Its Power

Lent began this past week on Ash Wednesday. It's a season of the church year preceding Holy Week and Easter. It's a time set aside for self-examination; a time when we consider the price Jesus paid for the sins of the world. During this season, we think about how Jesus, God's Son, took our place, suffering humiliation, torture, and eventually death to pay the price for our forgiveness.

Sir Arthur Conan Doyle, of Sherlock Holmes fame, in his history of the Boer War, tells how one relatively small unit of the British army was surprised by a force of the enemy twice its own strength. The British were driven back into their camp, while the Boers held a commanding position not far away. For hours, the enemy poured volley after volley of artillery fire into the English lines. The British wounded found themselves in a terrible position, laid out in the open under seemingly endless fire. One of the injured, a corporal in the Infantry, later told this story himself:

One officer shouted, "We must get up a red flag or we shall be blown from the face of the earth." We had a pillowcase but no red paint. Then we saw what to do instead. They made a bold red line going up and down on the pillowcase with my blood and another going side to side with Paul's."

This grim flag, the blood red cross upon the white background, was respected by the Boers. Those lying beneath it were safe. In the same way, when we lay beneath the blood stained Cross of Christ we find our sure refuge.

1 Cor. 1:18 For the word of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.

That blood-stained cross outside of Jerusalem, the place where Jesus suffered and died such a gruesome and agonizing death, was, and is, a place of foolishness and mockery for the enemies of God. It just didn't make any sense, and to many, still doesn't. It appeared that Jesus had failed, when in reality, He had done exactly what was required. That bloodstained cross has, and will continue to act as a covering and protection for anyone who cries out to God for mercy.
