I was once alive apart from the Law; but when the commandment came, sin became alive and I died..."

True life is not found in doing what we please, when we want to do it. A true and contented life is found when we live in right relationship with God...doing as He has directed in His Word. That is how we're wired. To live autonomously is to be in bondage to our own selfishness and pride - and that is a sorry condition indeed. So live for Christ today, following God's directives, and you will find a peace and contentment that surpasses all worldly promises.
